

COMPARATIVES					
Comparatives in English are used in statements where it is wanted to mention differences between two objects, places or people (nouns)					
The comparatives have different functions: emphasizing superiority, equality and inferiority and every one of them have different structure.					
COMPARATIVES Superiority (Than)					
are used to contrast the qualities of <u>two</u> people or objects.					
When adjectives are one or two syllables, (short adjectives) the ending -er is used, then "than" is written plus the complement (noun).					
For example:					
- Today is colder than yesterday. - The dog is faster than the turtle. - The apple is smaller than the watermelon					
COMPARATIVE Superiority FORM Short Adjectives					
Noun+verb TO BE+ADJECTIVE+ ER +THAN Complement					
Today is colder than yesterday					

**NOTE: some two syllables adjectives can be considered long in English.
