Using Comparative Adjectives

Comparative structures: things or people that are the same

First, we can use '**as ... as**' with a normal adjective (not a comparative) to say two things are the same:

SUBJECT	VERB TO BE	AS + ADJECTIVE + AS	COMPARISON	
Donald	is	AS tall AS	Abraham	(= they are the same height).
The red flag	is	AS expensive AS	the blue flag	(= they are the same price).

We can say that something is more than another thing by using a comparative adjective with 'than'.

- Brazil **is bigger than** Belice.
- My book **is more interesting than** your book.

We can say that one thing or person is less than another thing by using 'less ... than':

- Johana **is less tall than** Alexia.
- Your book **is less interesting than** my book.

Using Superlative Adjectives

We use a superlative to say that a thing or person is the most of a group. When we use a superlative adjective ('the tallest student') before the noun, we generally use it with 'the'.

- Kait and Amy are **the most intelligent** students here.
- This church is **the biggest** one.



Adjectives with one syllable. (Short Adjectives)

Usually if an adjective has only one syllable,
we add 'ER' to make the COMPARATIVE FORM.
We add 'EST' to make the SUPERLATIVE FORM.

ADJECTIVE	COMPARATIVE FORM	
	ADJECTIVE + ER	THAN
clean	cleaner	than
cold	colder	than
small	smaller	than
young	younger	than
tall	taller	than

ADJECTIVE	SUPERLATIVE FORM	
	THE	ADJECTIVE + EST
Clean	the	cleanest
Cold	the	coldest
Small	the	smallest
Young	the	youngest
Tall	the	tallest

There are some spelling changes. If there is one vowel followed by one consonant at the end of the adjective, we often double the consonant.

ADJECTIVE	COMPARATIVE FORM	
	ADJECTIVE + ER	THAN
wet	wetter	than
big	bigger	than
hot	hotter	than
thin	thinner	than

ADJECTIVE	SUPERLATIVE FORM	
	THE	ADJECTIVE + EST
wet	the	wettest
big	the	biggest
hot	the	hottest
thin	the	thinnest

If the adjective ends in 'y', this often changes to 'i'.

ADJECTIVE	COMPARATIVE FORM	
	ADJECTIVE+IER	THAN
dry	drier	than

ADJECTIVE	SUPERLATIVE FORM	
	THE	ADJECTIVE + IEST
dry	the	driest

If the adjective ends in 'e', we don't add another 'e', just 'r'.

ADJECTIVE	COMPARATIVE FORM	
	ADJECTIVE+ER	THAN
nice	nicer	than
large	larger	than

ADJECTIVE	SUPERLATIVE FORM	
	THE	ADJECTIVE + EST
nice	the	nicest
large	the	largest



There are a few adjectives that we have to use 'more' or 'most' with, even though they only have one syllable. We CAN'T add 'er' or 'est'.

	THE	MOST	ADJECTIVE
fun	THE	MOST	FUN
real	THE	MOST	REAL
right	THE	MOST	RIGHT
wrong	THE	MOST	WRONG

Adjectives with two or more syllables

For adjectives with two or more syllables we generally use 'MORE' or 'MOST'.

ADJECTIVE	COMPARATIVE FORM (MORE+THAN)		
	MORE	ADJECTIVE	THAN
careful	MORE	CAREFUL	THAN
bored	MORE	BORED	THAN
expensive	MORE	EXPENSIVE	THAN
beautiful	MORE	BEAUTIFUL	THAN
interesting	MORE	INTERESTING	THAN
Intelligent	MORE	INTELLIGENT	THAN

	THE	MOST	ADJECTIVE
careful	THE	MOST	CAREFUL
bored	THE	MOST	BORED
expensive	THE	MOST	EXPENSIVE
beautiful	THE	MOST	BEAUTIFUL
interesting	THE	MOST	INTERESTING
Intelligent	THE	MOST	INTELLIGENT

Adjectives with two syllables or more, that end in 'y' usually can add 'ER' or 'EST' (y generally changes to i). It's also fine to use 'more' or 'most'.

Irregular adjectives

There are also some irregular adjectives. We just need to learn these forms.

	ADJECTIVE	THAN	THE	ADJECTIVE
good	BETTER	than	THE	BEST
bad	WORSE	than	THE	WORST
far	FARTHER	than	THE	FARTHEST
little	LESS	than	THE	LEAST
